

# New data sources and data collection methods are omnipresent and part of our lives

- ⇒ People leave a digital footprint all the time (unwanted or wanted)
- ⇒ Human activity or mobility can now be captured in a way that was previously not possible with traditional methods (surveys)
- ⇒ Tourism can be seen as a 'special case' of human activity or mobility
- ⇒ Tourism statistics is seen as a frontrunner in exploring big data

## The path to the joint paper


- 4. Agreement between EUROSTAT and UNWTO to republish the paper as a joint effort in the UNWTO **Issue Paper Series**

  - Introduced by a scoping Executive Summary
